Martin Riseley (Violin)

After studies at the University of Canterbury School of Music and winning the Guarantee Corporation Young Achievers Award he graduated with a Bachelor of Music. From Juilliard School in the USA he has a Doctorate of Musical Arts degrees.

During his time in the USA, Martin was a teaching fellow in the Pre-College Division of Juilliard and also taught at the 92nd Street 'Y'. In Canada he was Concertmaster of the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra. He is currently Concertmaster of the Christchurch Symphony Orchestra and Associate Professor, Head of String/Violin/Orchestra at Te Koki School of Music.

Inbal Megiddo (Cello)

Inbal Megiddo holds graduate degrees from Yale University. Among the world-class orchestras and groups she has performed with are the Berlin Symphony, and the Jerusalem Symphony.

Inbal taught at Yale University for five years and has given master classes at universities and festivals worldwide. She was selected by the Stradivari Society as a rising star, receiving use of a Stradivarius cello on loan. She is Senior Lecturer, Classical Performance at Te Koki School of Music.

Jian Liu (piano)

Jian Liu has appeared on concert stages in China, Japan, Singapore, Portugal, Switzerland, Ukraine, the United States and New Zealand. He trained at the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing and has served as the faculty collaborative pianist and instructor at the Yale School of Music. He holds a Doctor of Musical Arts from the Yale School of Music.

He is currently Programme Leader, Classical Performance and Senior Lecturer at Te Koki School of Music as well as the honorary piano professor at Qingdao University in China.
